Admissions requirements for Bachelor Programmes:

The Applicant should obtain a Secondary School Certificate or its equivalent certified by the Ministry of Education in the Kingdom of Bahrain with an average no less than 60% or equivalent.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS & DOCUMENTS

- In some programmes, the Applicants admitted from non-scientific secondary school fields should pass foundation courses.
- All Applicants admitted to the University should take an obligatory placement test to determine their English language level.

Admissions requirements Master Programmes:

- Holding a Bachelor Degree or its equivalent from a University or College acknowledged by the Ministry of Education in the Kingdom of Bahrain.
- The required Master programme should be related to the Bachelor Degree Programme. If not, the applicant should pass a number of pre-sessional courses approved by the University.

- The applicant should be the holder of a Bachelor's Degree with a grade not less than (Good) or the equivalent to be admitted.
- The applicant is subject to an English placement test. If the applicant does not pass, it will be repeated within the period of study.
- The applicant should pass an interview conducted by the Scientific Department Committee.
- The applicant submits two recommendation letters, preferred one from a faculty staff member and the other from the University where the applicant has graduated.
- The applicant should have experience of not less than one year in a relevant professional field, except those obtaining a grade not less than (Very Good) or equivalent.
- The applicant is exempt from the placement test if he/she obtained the score of 450 in the TOEFL test or 4.5 in the IELTS test.
